Isaiah 40:28

READ: Genesis 16:13

Day One

All throughout the Big God Story, people have learned about who God is. A woman who was in need received help from God, and she gave Him a special name that day.

- When is a time you looked to see God?

- When is a time you felt like God saw you when you needed Him?

THANK God for giving you His word so you can know Him.

READ: Exodus 3:14

Day Two

God introduced Himself to Moses as the Lord, King of Kings, and the Holy One and God desires for you to know Him in that way too.

- What did God say His name is?

- Take a piece of paper and write a name that you would give to God. Decorate this as you please and place it somewhere that you will see often so you will be reminded of who HE is!

KNOW that God is the Lord over all.

READ: Exodus 20:7

Day Three

God knew that giving His name to Moses was a very important thing. When God gave the Ten Commandments, He asked people to honor His name because it describes who He is.

- Why shouldn't we misuse God's name?

- How can we honor God through the way we speak about Him?

ASK God to help you honor Him throughout this week.

READ: Colossians 3:17

Day Four

We learned this weekend that God is the Lord. But when Jesus came, people understood even more things about God. Jesus is God, and because of that, He deserves the same honor!
