Psalm 136:12

READ: Psalm 46:7-11

Day One

God is called "Lord Almighty" because of His power over all the earth. There is no one greater than Him!

- What do these verses tell you about the Lord Almighty?

- Why does God tell us to "Be still, and know that I am God"?

KNOW that there is no one greater than God.

READ: Psalm 89:7-8

Day Two

God is Lord Almighty! He was mighty to give Hannah a son, mighty to speak to Samuel, and mighty to give the people of Israel a new priest who would follow after God.

- What does it mean that God is greatly feared?

- How have you seen God's faithfulness in your life?

TRUST that God's faithfulness surrounds you.

READ: John 10:4-5

Day Three

In this passage Jesus compared hearing Him to sheep hearing their shepherd. God can speak to us in many ways—through His Word, a person, a song and so much more.

- How do sheep learn to know their shepherd's voice so well?

- How can we get to know Jesus' voice better?

ASK God to speak to you in some way this week.

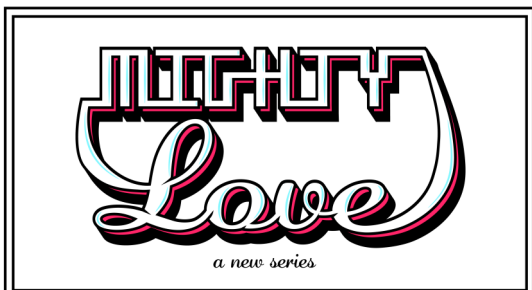
READ: Psalm 136:12
