Works: Approximately 25 hours/week, Salary (*weekends mandatory*)

Weekend Worship / Mid-week Programs – 75%

- Coordinate mid-week and/or weekend programs and activities.
- Schedule and supervise volunteers for weekend and mid-week programs.
- Assist with Biblical curriculum preparation.
- Foster a sense of spiritual community among volunteers.
- Prepare resource and craft materials to support curriculum.
- Ensure classrooms are prepared and ready for volunteers.

Parents – 10%

- Provide families with resources for personal and spiritual growth.
- Provides parent information regarding curriculum and upcoming activities.

Other Ministry – 15%

- Cultivate intimacy with God and growth in Christ-like character through personal and corporate spiritual disciplines.
- Assist in creating age-appropriate environments for kids to experience God.
- Attend Early Childhood leadership team meetings, church all-staff meetings, devotions and trainings.
- Assist with other Early Childhood programs and needs.
