Zephaniah 3:17

READ: Romans 3:21-24

Day One

On our own, none of us is perfectly righteous. God declares us righteous through His son, Jesus', death on the cross. We all need Jesus.

- What does the word righteous mean?

- What does it mean when it says that "no one [is] righteous"?

THANK Jesus for being our righteousness.

READ: John 3:16

Day Two

Without Jesus no one is righteous. But because God loved us, He sent Jesus to be our Savior. Jesus, God's son, came to take away our sins and give us His righteousness. Because of Jesus, we can have His righteous hearts worthy to give as gifts to God.

- What did God do because He loved us?

- How can we invite Jesus to be our Savior?

ASK God to help us live everyday for His glory.

READ: Romans 3:25-28

Day Three

We can't be righteous on our own, because only God is perfect and righteous all the time. But when we put our faith in Jesus, God looks at us and sees the righteousness that Jesus gave us.

- What does it mean to have Jesus as our righteousness?

- Why do we need Jesus to be our righteousness?

KNOW that God loves us.

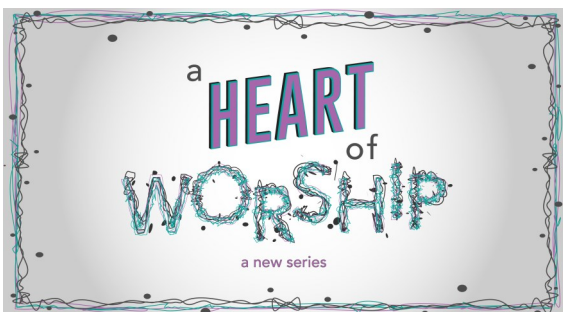
READ: Zephaniah 3:17
