Galatians 2:20

READ: Luke 2:13-14

Day One

As our King, Jesus is in charge, and He brings peace. The angels sang about this peace when Jesus was a baby.

- What did the angels sing when Jesus was born?

- How does it make you feel to know that Jesus, our King, brings peace?

KNOW that Jesus is King.

READ: Isaiah 61:1

Day Two

Hundreds of years before Jesus' birth, Isaiah told a prophecy about the kind of King Jesus would be.

- What did Jesus come to do?

- How have you seen Jesus do these things for you?

PRAISE God for the Good News of Jesus.

READ: Matthew 20:26-28

Day Three

Jesus talked a lot about His kingdom. He talked about a kingdom that is completely different from any other kind of kingdom on earth.

- How does a person become great in Jesus' kingdom?

ASK Jesus to help you serve others.

READ: Galatians 2:20

Day Four

Take pieces of paper or index cards and write one word of the above verse on each card. Mix all of the cards up and practice unscrambling the words to create the verse.
