Isaiah 41:10

READ: Psalm 17:6

Day One

God answered the prayers of His people, and Peter was miraculously freed from prison. We can always turn to God and trust that He will answer us!

- What are some things you pray about?

- How does it feel to know God hears you when you talk with Him?

KNOW that God always answers our prayers!

READ: Psalm 50:15

Day Two

We can always turn to God when we're in trouble—He will help us! He knows about everything in our lives, good and bad, and He cares about each of us.

- Why does God want us to pray to Him when things are hard?

- In what ways has God delivered—or rescued—you when you turned to Him?

REMEMBER to call on God in every situation.

READ: Philippians 4:6

Day Three

The Bible tells us that instead of worrying, we can pray to God. It's so good to know that God listens to us and answers our prayers.

- What are some things you worry about?

- Why does it help to pray when we're worried?

ASK God for help when you worry.

READ: Romans 12:12

Day Four

The Bible reminds us that when things are tough we can still have joy and stay faithful in our prayers. God has an amazing plan and He loves us so much.

- How can we be faithful in prayer?

- How can joy, patience, and faithfulness help us know God better?

SEEK to be joyful and faithful in prayer all the time.
