**READ: Acts 1:7-9; 2:1-4**

**Day One**

## READ: Acts 12:1-19

## Day Three

A king named Herod Agrippa threw Peter in prison for telling people about Jesus. But the Christians were praying. And one night, as Peter was sleeping in the jail, surrounded by guards, an angel of the Lord appeared and a light shone in the cell. The angel told Peter to get up, and the chains fell off of Peter's wrists. God caused the heavy iron gate to open in front of them, and Peter and the angel walked right out of jail without the guards knowing! Peter then went to the home of the Christians who were praying for him. They were overjoyed at the way God answers prayer!

## READ: Acts 16:6-15

## Day Four

During Paul's missionary travels, God spoke to him through a dream in which a man appeared and begged Paul to come to Macedonia and help them. So Paul and his friends went to Macedonia and arrived in a city called Philippi. They went down to the river and started talking to a group of Jewish women. One of those women was named Lydia. The Lord opened Lydia's heart to hear Paul's message, and she became a follower of Jesus! Lydia and the other members of her household worked together with other new believers to create a new church in Philippi. The Holy Spirit spoke to Paul to guide him, and He still speaks to us today.
