READ: Genesis 1:1-26

Day One

READ: Ephesians 2:4-5

Day Two

Everything didn't stay perfect. Adam and Eve disobeyed God bringing sin into the world. God promised to send a redeemer. Though God could have turned away from the first people because of their sin, He didn't. God is love, and His perfect love covers us.

- How does God cover—or forgive—our sin?

KNOW God's great love for you.

READ: Hebrews 9:26-28

Day Three

Sin brought death, pain, and sadness into the world. These things were never supposed to be a part of our world, which is why they're so difficult for us to deal with. Because God is holy, He must judge sin. But because He is loving, He is willing to forgive sin—through Jesus' perfect sacrifice on the cross.

- Who did God send to redeem us?

- How does it make you feel to know God made the way for us to be in perfect relationship with Him again?

THANK God for sending His Son to save us.

READ: Revelation 21:3-4

Day Four

One day Jesus will return to remake the heavens and earth and restore them to perfection, without sin and death. Then all people who trust and follow Him will be brought to their new home with Him.

- What do you think it will be like when someday God restores all of creation to how it was in the beginning?

TRUST that Jesus will return and make all things new!
