Deuteronomy 7:9

READ: Romans 5:15-16

Day One

Even though people completely turned their back on God, God showed His grace and mercy by keeping the promise He'd made in the garden of Eden—to redeem people back to Himself through Jesus.

- What did God promise?

- How did God fulfill this promise?

REMEMBER God keeps His promises.

READ: Isaiah 54:9-10

Day Two

Our God keeps His word! Other writers in the Bible mention God's covenant with Noah as an example of a time when God kept His word.

- What do these verse tell us about God?

- Because God has kept His word in the past, what does that tell us about God keeping His word in the future?

KNOW that God is faithful.

READ: Proverbs 3:5-6

Day Three

The Bible is full of God's promises to us. They tell us who He is and what He promises to do in our lives.

- What does God promise in these verse?

- Have you ever asked God to show you what to do? If so, write it out.

TRUST that God has a plan.

READ: Romans 8:38-39

Day Four

Throughout the Bible God has made many promises and keeps each and every one of them. God has also made many promises to us throughout Scripture.

- According to these verses, what can separate us from God's love?

- How does it make you feel to know that God keeps His promises?
