Remember Verse

“Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord your God goes with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you.”

Week One

November 3-4

Deuteronomy 31:6

READ: Exodus 20:2-3

Day One

God gave His people clear commands about how they were to serve Him. He did this through giving them the Ten Commandments.

- What was the first commandment?

- Why do you think this commandment was and is so important to God?

SEEK to follow the ten commandments.

READ: Judges 2:10-15

Day Two

God wanted the Israelites to worship Him alone and not other gods. Because of this, He wanted them to drive out the other people who would sway them to worship false gods.

- What do these verses explain about how the Israelites failed to obey God?

- Do you think God had a plan when He allowed foreign nations to take over His people?

WORSHIP the one true God.

READ: Psalm 51:10-12

Day Three

When God's people rebelled against Him, there were consequences for their sins: God allowed foreign rulers to overtake them. He did this so that His people would remember what He told them.

- How does God respond to us today when we repent, or turn away from our sins?

- How does it make you feel to know that God delivers us from our sins?

TRUST God to deliver you from sin.

READ: Psalm 57:2-3

Day Four

We see both in the lives of the Israelites and in our own lives today that God continually delivers His people when they repent (or turn back) to Him. God hears our cries and delivers us.

- How does God still respond when we cry to Him?

- How does God "restore" His people or bring them into right relationship with Him?

KNOW that God hears our cries and delivers us.
