READ: 2 Corinthians 9:8

Day One

READ: 2 Peter 1:3

Day Two

Whatever you’re needing right now—God can fill that place in your life. If life is difficult for you, like it was for the Israelites, God wants to care for you and help you depend on Him. Nothing and no one else can satisfy you.

- What does this verse tell you about how God is enough for us?

- What are some things God has given us to help us live godly lives?

KNOW that God works all things for good.

READ: John 10:10

Day Three

Though the one true God chose the Israelites to be His holy people, that same God of the universe has also offered us the opportunity to be in relationship with Him. He has offered us so much more than the rest of the world offers.

- In what way does Jesus give us the best kind of life?

- Write about how God has blessed you with a life that is better than anything the world can offer.

PRAISE God that He is enough.

READ: Philippians 4:11-13


Day Four
