1. God has a plan for Our Life (Gen. 25:1-23) (Gen. 26:3-6; 12-13; 23-25; 28a)

Romans 8:28-29: ²⁸ And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. ²⁹ For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

2. But we are responsible for Our Choices (Gen. 25:24-34) (Gen. 27:1-41)

Hebrews 12:16: See that no one is sexually immoral, or is godless like Esau, who for a single meal sold his inheritance rights as the oldest son.

3. We deal with Our Consequences, God accomplishes His Will (Gen. 27:42-46; 28:1-9)
