Week Two

February 9-10

Psalm 83:18

READ: Ephesians 2:3-5

Day One

The Ninevites were mean people, and they were mean to God's people, the Israelites. But, God chose to send a prophet to speak His message to them and rescue them from their sin because He is merciful.

- How could you explain God's great love to others?

- How can we show God we're thankful for His mercy?

KNOW that God is merciful.

READ: Psalm 86:5-7

Day Two

God is merciful and wants everyone to know Him. Just like it brought God joy to show mercy to the Ninevites, it brings Him joy to show mercy on us today.

- What happens when we call to God?

- What does this tell us about God's love for people?

TRUST that God is still merciful today.

READ: Titus 3:3-6

Day Three

The most important way God showed us His mercy was by sending Jesus to die for us on the cross. Because of God's mercy—not what we have done—He saved us.

- What changed when God's love appeared?

- How has God shown you mercy?

THANK God for saving us.

READ: Hebrew 4:16

Day Four

Mercy means not getting the punishment you deserve. Because God is merciful, we can come to Him in prayer with anything we need.

- What does the word Mercy mean?

- In what ways do you need God's mercy today?

REJOICE that we can come to God with all our needs!
