1 John 4:9

READ: Psalm 145:3

Day One

Mary knew that Jesus is worthy of everything she had to give Him: her time, her life, her love, and her worship. Jesus was worthy.

- Why is Jesus worthy of our praise?

- How can we honor Jesus and worship Him with our lives?

REMEMBER that Jesus is worthy of our praise.

READ: Ephesians 5:1

Day Two

Being a disciple means we become like our teacher. In Jesus' day, when a student left home to follow a rabbi, he started to imitate everything his teacher did so he could become like him.

- What does it mean to follow someone's example?

- What are some things God does that we can do in our lives?

THANK God for being the leader of our lives.

READ: Matthew 11:29

Day Three

The more we learn from God, the more He'll continue to show us the most important thing. He'll help us see the things that distract us from spending time with Him.

- What kind of teacher is Jesus?

- In what ways did Jesus show Himself to be humble and gentle to Mary and Martha?

KNOW that Jesus is our teacher.

READ: John 8:31

Day Four

Jesus is worthy of worship, praise, adoration, and devotion because He is the Son of God, the healer of the sick, the Savior of the world! He is worthy!

- What does this verse say about true disciples?

- What kind of things can we do to continue to learn more about Jesus and His Word?
