Teaching and Classroom Management - 80%

- Give full attention to safety, physical and emotional well-being of the children.
- Plan and arrange classroom activities through use of whole group instruction, independent learning centers and directed small groups.
- Daily classroom set up.
- Supervise playground activity.

Spiritual Leadership - 10%

- Cultivate intimacy with God and growth in Christ-like character through personal and corporate spiritual disciplines.
- Participate in daily preschool staff devotions and prayer.
- Model Biblical principles in interactions with parents and children. Communicate the gospel message as you have opportunity.
- Incorporate faith principles into curriculum and classroom environment.

Administrative - 10%

- Participate in staff meetings.

Applicants must have 12 ECE units from an accredited State-approved school and at least 6 months experience in a satisfactory role.
