4. As Christ followers what does it mean to have liberty of conscience? Why do you think Paul says that the faith we have is to be kept between ourselves and God? How should we apply that truth today?
5. Reflection: Take some time to think through and pray about what you might be unwilling to sacrifice for the peace, unity, and greater good of God's kingdom and others? How does the example of Christ, that we see in Philippians 2:3-8, help us?
