1. What did God lay on your heart through your personal study of these verses?
2. What verse from the Roman's Road is most meaningful to you, and why?

Roman's Road

Romans 3:23, for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

Romans 6:23, For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in^[a] Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 5:8, But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Romans 10: 9-10, ⁹ If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

3. Have you ever been to a sermon or Biblical class where you felt the truth had been skewed to some degree? What was shared? How did you feel about it? What did you do about it? Would you do anything differently now?
4. Of the three suggestions to be able to discern what is from God, which do you find the most useful and which one do you use the least? Why do you think that is?
