

**John 9—Jesus Heals a Man Born Blind**  
**Man Born Blind Book**

**Supplies**

- copies of the Man Born Blind Book (1 per child)
- crayons or washable markers
- scissors



**Directions**

Help the children color and cut out the Man Born Blind Book. Show children how to fold the book in half so that scenes 1 and 4 are behind scenes 2 and 3. Lay the book down so that scenes 2 and 3 are facing you. Fold the book in half so that scene 4 is the back of the book and scene 1 is the front (see the example). Children can use the books to retell the story of Jesus healing a man born blind:

- 1) Jesus was walking and saw a man who had been born blind. Jesus spit on the ground and made mud.
- 2) Jesus put the mud on the man's eyes.
- 3) Jesus told the man to go and wash in the Pool of Siloam. The man did what Jesus said.
- 4) The man could see! People asked him what had happened and he told them what Jesus had done for him.
