


"Little Helper" 2 Kings 5:1-14

Bible Truth: I can remind others about God, no matter how little I am!

Bible Story:

Naaman had a disease called leprosy. No doctor could help Naaman get better.

His servant girl said, "Elisha loves God. He could heal your leprosy."

Naaman visited Elisha's house. His servant came outside and said, "Elisha says, "Wash seven times in the Jordan River. Then you will be healed."

Naaman became angry. He didn't want to wash in the Jordan River.

Naaman's friend said, "Sir, you've come all this way. See what happens!"

Naaman went to the Jordan River. One, two, three, four times Naaman washed and nothing happened. Five, six, and seven, when he came out of the water, Naaman's leprosy was gone! God had healed him!

Naaman rode back to Elisha's house. He told Elisha, "God can do anything! I want to follow the Lord for the rest of my life!"
