



Disability Inclusion Ministry Assistant

The Grove's Disability Inclusion Ministry exists to create an environment and community where people and families impacted by disabilities can be introduced to Jesus and transformed by him. The Ministry Assistant position is designed to assist in cultivating an inclusive environment at The Grove so that families and people impacted by disabilities can feel loved, seen, supported and welcomed. As a part of the Disability Inclusion ministry team, this role will play a significant role in strategizing, as well as in assessing and evaluating ministry initiatives. The Disability Inclusion Ministry Assistant works significantly with both The Grove Preschool team and The Grove's other ministry teams.

Works with: Disability Inclusion ministry team, volunteers, families, Grove Preschool staff, Grove ministry teams
Works: Part Time, approximately 20-25 hours per week

Preschool Support - 50%

- Serve as a support for preschool students with disabilities or who exhibit more difficult behavioral patterns.
- Support families at the preschool going through the diagnosis process.
- Create and implement student disability inclusion plans.
- Assist teachers in creating an inclusive environment.

Disability Inclusion Ministry Leadership - 40%

- Serve as part of the Disability inclusion ministry leadership team, which crafts vision, mission and values of the disability inclusion ministry.
- Serve as a one-on-one for people with disabilities during ministry activities.
- Assist with leading and coordinating weekly volunteer meetings.
- Assist with leading and coordinating new volunteer trainings.
- Assist with leading and coordinating monthly respite nights.
- Equip ministry leaders and volunteers with skills to increase inclusivity.
- Support families within the Disability Inclusion ministry.
- Attend services and ministry events.

Other Ministry - 10%

- Cultivate intimacy with God and growth in Christ-like character through personal and corporate spiritual disciplines.
- Attend disability inclusion ministry team meetings, church all-staff meetings, devotions and trainings.
