Food - 75%

- Assist Lead Chef.
- Prepare or finish food for events and café weekend services.
- Perform frequent checks to ensure consistent high quality of preparation and service.
- Ensure sanitary practices for food handling, cleanliness and maintenance of kitchen areas; comply with all health and safety regulations.

Other - 25%

- Set up banquet facilities when needed.
- Lead banquet staff and buffet lines.
- Clean and maintain all kitchen area and equipment.
- Deep cleaning of kitchen, walk in, freezer and Hub areas once per week.
- Stock supplies from the back of house to the front of house once per week.
- Receive orders when needed.
