A JOURNEY THROUGH THE WILDERNESS

1. What type of situations or circumstances that have happened in your life seem like a set-back at first? How did God show you He used it for your good and His glory? How does the redemption of Aaron's life give us hope? (Remember Aaron went from the golden calf incident to being consecrated as priest of Israel.)
2. Discuss the significance & difference of the census in Chs. 3 and 4. What does it tell us about God's plan? Based off of what we understand about why the Levites were chosen, why is it important to follow God? How can understanding that truth be applied in our lives today?
3. What is the importance of the priests and Levites encamped between the tabernacle and the other tribes? Is there any meaning in that purposeful position of their encampment that relates to us today? What does that tell us about God's faithfulness?
4. Who or what has God purposefully positioned in your life that you know is from Him? What things might you be overlooking that God has purposefully positioned in your life that you necessarily don't prefer? How can our attitudes and hearts reflect trust in God even though our journey with Him might look different than others?
